SBCC Minutes – 2023-12-06

Welcome and Recap (5 minutes) – Serafin
 Serafin started the meeting with the agenda and noted that there will be a topping off ceremony taking
 place on January 17, 2024. The ceremony will not be open to the public, but instead be more intimate to
 focus on recognizing the work force for all their hard work on reaching this milestone. Ceremony will
 include beam signing for all participants.

Sewer connection approval for the site is on the last stage with LAFCO and will be reviewed on 12/14/2023. Christina Selvin suggested for a press release after LAFCO approval of sewer connection.

Project Updates (5 minutes) – Damon
 The site has been winterized. All paths of travel for vehicles now have base rock and building pad has received a section of crush rock allowing for protection in case of any major rainstorms.

Steel has arrived on site and the erection for the building has begun.

Joint trenching for power and data are ongoing for the main site and off-site improvements. Both will eventually connect at the interception of Cielo Vista Dr. and Fairview Rd.

Currently the project is ahead of schedule.

Elizabeth San Ramon requested for local arts to be involved with any community art on campus.

- Furniture selection update

 Serafin emphasized how important it is for everyone to vote on the furniture provided by the

 three vendors. Vendors will be on campus for presentations on Monday 12/11/23. Selection will

 need to be made soon for procurement.

 reminded everyone that this name is only for the campus, not the actual building.

- Security update
 David Farmer, Security Supervisor for Gavilan College, informed everyone that district personal
 from IT department and security have been working with the construction and design teams to
 come up with a system that best fits Gavilan College. System will include the capability of
 having remote access and facial recognition.

Serafin addresses everyone that the district has been working closely with the local Sherriff Department to determine logistics of active shooter and the glass windows. At this moment the Sherriff's Department is recommended to leave the design of the windows as is. The district will revisit the option of adding some type of protective film on the windows.
